

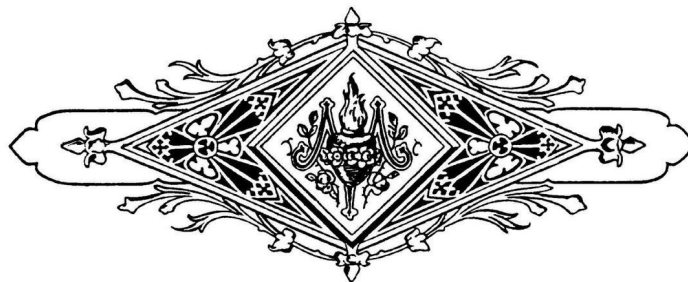

You may be asked to participate in liturgies as a lector, extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, altar server, or liturgical musician. You may also be asked to share your faith through witness talks to the youth of our parish. Recognizing that the Holy Spirit has given each unique person different talents to put at the service of God no one will be forced to do any of these things, but only asked and encouraged to volunteer for these roles with the understanding that volunteering for the needs of the Church is expected (In other words, you are expected to volunteer for something, but you get to choose what and when). You also reaffirm your adherence to the code of conduct signed in the parish waiver. As a youth leader you commit to further understanding, pursuing, and using the 7 gifts given to you by the Holy Spirit in your Baptism and sealed in your Confirmation so that they may bear fruit in our parish and in the world.
