

Discipline Policy for Youth Formation

A discipline policy will be put into place for youth formation for this upcoming year. There will be consequences put into place if a child acts inappropriately and in a way that is disrupting class. These behaviors can include but are not limited:

- Swearing
- Gossiping or negative talk
- Talking back to the teacher, helper, or other volunteers
- Talking when the teacher or other students are talking
- Refusing to participate in the lesson or activities such as not following along in the book.

If your child is engaging in these behaviors during youth formation there will be consequences for their actions.

- 1st offence: The student will be removed from class for some time to talk about their behavior with either the hallway volunteer, classroom helper, or Director of Catechesis and will be given a warning.
- 2nd offence: The student will be removed from class, and the student and Director of Catechesis will call the parent/guardian to explain what happened and remind them that if this behavior continues they will need to join their child at youth formation.
- 3rd offence: The parent/guardian will join their child for youth formation.
- 4th offence: The child will be removed from the class and will be taught individually with their parent present.
- 5th offence: The child will be removed from youth formation, a refund will not be given, and materials will be sent home for the child to continue their learning.
