LENTEN REGULATIONS

Catholics join in a common observance of penance during Lent. We set aside days to exercise works of prayer, fasting and charity.

ABSTINENCE: *Not eating meat.*

- *Is for all Catholics 14 years and older.*
- *Is required on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday.*

FASTING: *Eating only one full meal a day and not eating between meals*

- *Is for all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59.*
- *Only one full meal, two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs.*
- *Is required on ASH WEDNESDAY & GOOD FRIDAY .*

EXCEPTIONS: *The obligation doesn't apply to those whose health would be affected seriously. People in doubt, consult a priest.*

The "Easter Triduum", the sacred three days, from Holy Thursday evening to Easter Sunday are celebrated as one great feast, the solemn celebration of the Church year. The Triduum is a commemoration of Jesus' death and resurrection into new life. We celebrate what we believe: that Christ by dying destroyed our death and by rising he restored our life.
